PROGRAM GOAL

To provide employment & education assistance to foster and former foster youth ages 16 to 25.

QUALIFYING CRITERIA

- Foster or former foster care
- Seeking employment
- Pursuing educational goals
- Intake must be completed and eligibility verified (TFW or PAL letter verifying dates in foster care) prior to assistance being provided.

SERVICES PROVIDED

- Monthly bus pass
- Emergency grocery assistance
- Assistance in completing education enrollment (clothing for school attendance)
- Assistance in obtaining employment (including pick up/drop off of applications, workforce enrollment, online application, and work uniform assistance.)
- Hygiene assistance
- State I.D. assistance for those seeking employment assistance.
- Educational Testing Fees
- School Supplies
- Employment Uniforms
- One set of Interview Clothing
- Referrals to qualified any agency programs, Workforce and community resources

PROGRAM LIMITATIONS

• Program participants must remain active in the program and be actively seeking employment, enrolling in educational programs, or maintaining employment and education.
